Lichfield 10k Prize Rules

1. Prizes will be awarded on the basis of the official 'gun times' in accordance with UKA Rules of Competition and the Event Rules.

2. The first male/female overall will be presented with the first male/female open prize, regardless of their age category.
3. Veterans are eligible for open individual prizes, but a runner can only win one cash/voucher prize (in addition to breaking the course record). (ie If a veteran comes second or third in the open race, they cannot win their age category cash prize, although they may still win the overall vet trophy)
4. The first male/female vet trophy (Lichfield Mercury/Waitrose Shield) will be awarded to the first male/female in any veteran category unless they have already been awarded the first male/female open prize. If the first male/female vet does not win an open prize, they will be awarded first male/female vet and also the first prize in their age category.
5. If a veteran wins the first open prize, the next veteran to finish will win the overall veteran prize and the first veteran to finish in each age category who has not already qualified for an open prize will receive the age group prize.
6. Money prizes will be in the form of cash or vouchers.
7. Should there be any doubt of discrepancies of the results, then the Lichfield 10k organisers reserve the right to withhold awarding a prize until the results become official (up to 14 days after the race).
8. All prize winners will be displayed on the event website within 14 days of the race.
9. Age on race day determines age category entitlement.
10. Awards in the Team category apply to UKA affiliated clubs and will be calculated on cumulative time (not finishing places).
11. All prizes and categories listed are subject to amendment.
12. Prizes will only be awarded based on the information submitted through the formal entry process. If runners have failed to supply any information relevant to the prize awards, then the data may not be included in the results after the race and they may not receive the relevant prize that could have been eligible for. It is the runners' responsibility to ensure their entrant data is submitted accurately.
13. Any runner falsely claiming a prize through their entry data, by claiming to be someone else, or by any other fraudulent method will result in the prize being withdrawn from them and the runner will be reported to UK Athletics.
14. If a winner does not receive their prize at the award ceremony on race day then their cash prize will be posted out to them. Trophies must be collected within 1 calendar month of the race day.
15. All appeals and correspondence to be addressed to the Race Director. The decision of the Race Referee shall be final.
